

## DPT Class of 2016 and 2017 Graduate Employment Report

**Timeframe:** Employment rate is defined by CAPTE as "the percentage of graduates who sought employment that were employed (full-time or part-time) as a physical therapist within 1 year following graduation." Employment data are collected for each cohort six months to one year after graduation. The Program graduates one cohort each year.

**Methodology:** An online DPT Graduate Survey is emailed to all DPT program graduates. However, only responses from graduates who have passed the licensure exam within one year following graduation are considered in this report, in accordance with CAPTE's employment reporting requirements. For those who have passed the licensure exam within one year following graduation but do not respond to the survey, employment may be confirmed via faculty reports, graduates' employers, and social media.

Official Source of Employment Data: the online DPT Graduate Survey

Unofficial Sources of Employment Data: faculty reports, employer websites, social media

Knowledge Rate: the number of responses received from all aforementioned sources in relation to the total number of graduates

Employment Rate: (# employed as a physical therapist full-time, part-time, temp/seasonal)/(total responses from official and unofficial sources - # not seeking employment)
