

The Canvas LMS

This document outlines the basics about Canvas, and what you need to know to get started.

What is Canvas?

Canvas is UJ's Learning Management System (LMS) - it is what hosts course shells and their gradebook and attendance records. For online students, the LMS also hosts course content.

How do I find Canvas?

Access Canvas from the launchpad on the MyUJ homepage.

What do I need to use Canvas?

Canvas identifies the following technical requirements for the best learning experience. You can see a summary below and <u>access the original article here</u> for more details.

Device Specifications

For best performance, it is recommended that you have a desktop or laptop that:

- can run on the most up-to-date web browser (the recommended browser is Chrome). Click here to test your browser and see the results of "Is My Browser up to Date?"
- has at least 1 GB of RAM.

Internet

It is recommended to have a minimum Internet speed of 512kbps.



Where can I learn to use Canvas?

After logging in for the first time, click on the Help menu and click the link to self-enroll in Canvas Orientation. This will get you familiar with how to navigate and use the site. **Orientation is required for all students to complete**.

What about the mobile experience?

If you want to access your learning on-the-go, we recommend downloading the Canvas app rather than relying on a mobile browser. You will have the option to set this up in your Canvas Orientation course. You can learn <u>more about the Student app here</u>.

Note: You will need to log in on a desktop or laptop first to authenticate your mobile app.

What about Privacy?

Like any LMS, Canvas will have access to a variety of personal information like your name, email, classes, and device information. Canvas "limit[s] [their] collection and use of your personal information only to those elements required to operate [their] Products, or as otherwise disclosed in this Privacy Notice.
